Submissions and Presentations

Prospective presenters are invited to electronically submit an abstract in 200-300 words. The abstract can be sent as email attachment, or simply in email text. The abstract must include paper title, author name(s) and full mailing address(es), as well as email address of the corresponding author. Abstracts should be sent to: eia@iseis.org.

Full-length papers should be submitted no later than June 15, 2004. Presentations can be made orally or/and by posters. No full paper submission is necessary for a presentation.

Publications

Full papers must be prepared based on the guidelines for publication in *Environmental Informatics Archives* (EIA), a series of volumes of ISEIS conference proceedings. The format requirements are simple and the guidelines are easy to follow with the use of the sample paper. 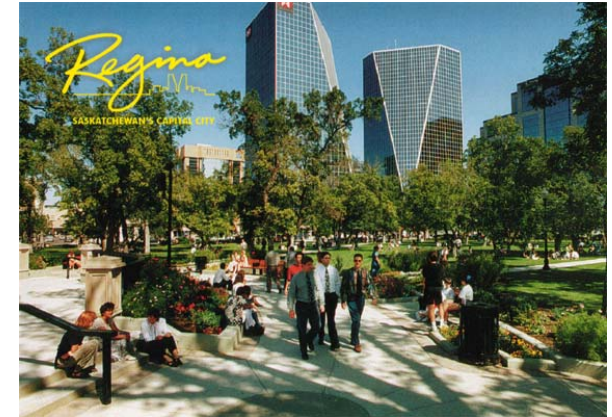
