5th International Conference on Environmental Informatics
August 1-3, Bowling Green, Kentucky, USA

You are enthusiastically invited to be a part of the 2006 International Society for Environmental Information Sciences (ISEIS) Conference to be held in Bowling Green, Kentucky from August 1-3, 2006. This 5th annual meeting will offer many opportunities for professional development and inspiration. A poster session will be open throughout the conference. We invite your abstract submissions for poster presentations. The submission deadline is June 1, 2006.

This conference will feature a new track on Sustainability in Higher Education. In 2002, the United Nations declared 2005-2014 the *Decade of Education for Sustainable Development*, in wide recognition of the global crisis in sustainability.¹ At this conference we hope to encourage a greater focus on sustainable development issues across universities, especially in the Commonwealth, and to discover new ways to model, seek and teach values of economic, social and environmental sustainability. Sessions, posters, mealtime conversations, educational expeditions, and other informal opportunities will all facilitate sharing of ideas and programs.

Requirements for Poster Presentations

- An abstract *must* be submitted for a poster if no full paper is submitted for the same work.
- Poster presentations will be on display for the entire conference beginning at 1:00 pm, August 1, 2006.
- The poster set-up will start at 10:00 a.m., August 1, 2006.
- Authors should bring their posters to the registration desk at the conference venue.
- Each poster will be assigned a poster board of approximately 110 cm (43 inches) wide x 140 cm (55 inches) high.
- Assistance and hardware for attaching posters will be provided.
- Presentation should consider the viewer's needs. Posters should be easy to read from a distance.
- The title, author and affiliations should be clearly displayed.
- No advertising of commercial products, processes or services is allowed unless approved by the conference committee.
- In case the space is not adequate to accommodate all the needs, priority will be first given to those who will not present orally, and then corporation/industry participants on a first-come, first-served basis.
