## **5th International Conference on Environmental Informatics August 1-3, 2006 Bowling Green, Kentucky, USA**

You are invited to be a part of the 2006 International Society for Environmental Information Sciences (ISEIS) Conference to be held in Bowling Green, Kentucky from August 1-3, 2006. A poster session will be open throughout the conference. We invite your abstract submissions for poster presentations. The submission deadline is June 1, 2006.

The Poster sessions will provide an excellent forum for authors to present their work in an informal and interactive setting. Posters are ideal for presenting speculative, late-breaking results or for giving an introduction to interesting, innovative work. Posters are intended to provide authors and participants with the ability to connect with each other and to engage in discussions about the work.

The posters will provide information about environmental informatics. Posters that present Work In Progress and draw important conclusions from practical experience are especially welcome. Posters are being solicited in areas including but not limited to:

- Marine environmental monitoring

- Monitoring and analytical techniques of environmental quality

- Environmental remote sensing and spatial information systems
- Spatial database for environmental planning
- Environmental sciences and artificial intelligence
- Dynamic and multi-dimensional environmental visualization

- GIS solutions for disaster management
- Process Control and Optimization in Environmental Engineering
- Simulation, optimization, and control of waste treatment and pollution reduction process

## Requirements for Poster Presentations

- An abstract must be submitted for a poster if no full paper is submitted for the same work.
- Poster presentations will be on display for the entire conference beginning at 1:00 pm, August 1, 2006.
- The poster set-up will begin at 10:00 a.m., August 1, 2006.
- Authors should bring their posters to the registration desk at the conference venue.
- Assistance and hardware for attaching posters will be provided.
- Presentation should consider the viewer's needs. Posters should be easy to read from a distance.
- The title, author and affiliations should be clearly displayed.
- No advertising of commercial products, processes or services is allowed unless approved by the conference committee.
- In case the space is not adequate to accommodate all the needs, priority will be first given to those who will not present orally, and then corporation/industry participants on a first-come, first-served basis.
